St. Andrew Academy's families have opportunities to apply for internal and external financial aid. In order to be eligible for financial aid, a Student Aid Form for 2012-2013 must be completed and sent to Private School Aid Service (PSAS) by **March 15, 2012** along with a processing fee of \$20. PSAS reviews the information and provides the school with information regarding the financial need of the family.

The PSAS Student Aid Form for 2012-2013 is available at the Academy Office and the Parish Office. If your family is interested in applying for Financial Aid, please contact the Academy or Parish Office to receive a Financial Aid Packet. **All necessary forms/applications are included in the Financial Aid Packet.**

External Financial Aid Sources

Catholic Education Foundation, Inc.

Catholic Education Foundation, Inc. (CEF) provides financial assistance to families throughout the Archdiocese of Louisville. In order to apply, a PSAS form needs to be completed and returned to PSAS. CEF works with PSAS to review and determine financial aid awards.

School CHOICE Scholarships

School CHOICE Scholarships is the only private voucher program in Kentucky and is the 16th largest private voucher initiative in the United States. To qualify the applicant must:

- Be living in and attending school in Jefferson County
- Be entering grades K through 6
- Qualify as low-income as defined by the Federal School Lunch guidelines

CHOICE Scholarships are awarded yearly in a random lottery drawing held without regard to race, religion, ethnic background, and academic achievement or test scores. Students are not required to have a certain grade point average to be awarded a scholarship. SCS realizes that students with lower scores may be the ones who most need the extra attention private schools may offer.

The 2012-2013 applications must be received by **March 30, 2012** application is included in Financial Aid Packet.

USDA Free and Reduce Lunch Program

St. Andrew Academy is a participant in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP). The NSLP is a federally assisted meal program operating in public and nonprofit private schools and residential child care institutions. It provides nutritionally balanced, low-cost or free lunches to children each school day. The program was established under the National School Lunch Act, signed by President Harry Truman in 1946.

Applications are will be made available when provided by the Archdiocese, typically in May.
